Vision:

Policy Statement:

St Mary's RC Primary School is committed to ensuring the safety and well-being of all pupils, staff, and visitors. To maintain a safe environment, dogs are not permitted on the school premises, with the exception of assistance dogs.

Purpose:

The purpose of this policy is to:

- Minimize the risk of injury.
- Ensure a safe and comfortable environment for all.
- Comply with health and safety regulations.

Scope:

This policy applies to all visitors, parents, guardians, staff, and pupils of St Mary's RC Primary School.

Exceptions:

- Assistance dogs, such as guide dogs for the visually impaired, are permitted on the premises.
- Prior approval from the school administration must be obtained for any other exceptions.

Implementation:

- 1. **Signage:** Clearly visible signs stating "No Dogs Allowed" will be placed at all school entrances.
- 2. **Communication:** The policy will be communicated to parents and guardians via newsletters, the school website, and during school meetings.

3. Enforcement:

- Staff members are authorized to remind visitors of the policy and politely ask them to remove their dogs from the premises.
- Repeated violations by individuals will result in further action, which may include being denied entry to the school grounds.

4. Review and Monitoring:

- o The policy will be reviewed annually by the school administration to ensure its effectiveness.
- o Feedback from the school community will be considered during the review process.

Responsibilities:

- **School Administration:** Responsible for the policy's implementation, monitoring, and review.
- Staff: Support the enforcement of the policy by reminding visitors of the rules.
- **Parents/Guardians:** Comply with the policy and ensure that dogs are not brought onto school premises.
