In the meantime, we have a relief Caretaker, so please continue to be patient during this time of transition. We are still in the thick of winter and more potential cold snaps are on the way. Please continue to take extra care during the winter season, always looking out for those hidden icy patches. Please also ensure your child comes to school well equipped with a warm coat, hat, scarf and gloves etc. We also advise that the children always have spare socks in their bag if their feet get wet, and ideally send in wellies/boots to change into when it's very wet/snowy. Above all, we want our children to become fluent readers and to enjoy reading!

All aspects of the curriculum and learning (especially as children move up to High School) is easier for children who can read well.

We expect all children across the whole school to read at home daily as part of their homework and we ask parents to support us and their child here. Children in Years 3-6 understand the expectations around Accelerated reader/Myon and our reward system where they get prizes for meeting their half termly reading targets. So get reading as reading means prizes!

Correct Uniform

A reminder to our parents about school uniform expectations. By sending your child to our school, there is an expectation that you follow our school policies including our school uniform policy. Even if parents disagree with aspects of our school policy, we still expect all children to follow our school rules, just as adults have to adhere to dress codes in many work places. Please note the following:

- Ties MUST be worn at all times. If they get lost, a replacement should be bought from school and cost £2.50 from the school office
- No jewellery apart from a plain watch (not apple/smart watches) and small plain studs (**not hoops**) and earrings MUST be removed for PE. Bracelets, wristbands and rings are not allowed
- School shoes should be plain, black, sensible and safe.
- Hairstyles should be sensible and not extreme.
- **Parents should speak to Mrs Ruane, the Class teacher or office staff if they are struggling financially and we can support here, discreetly of course.**

Attendance and Punctuality

Please ensure your child is always here on time to start the school day **prompt at 8.45am**. We appreciate that traffic can be terrible getting in and out of Littleborough at times. And it can really catch us all out! However, we ask our parents to do your best to work around this and get your child to school on time as they miss so much valuable time with five/ten minutes lateness here and there.
