Reading and homework—further reminder!

Parents, please ensure your child is doing what they are expected to do. Ask their teacher if you are still unsure. Our older children do not necessarily need an adult to sit with them but please remind and encourage them to do their reading and homework. It is important that they learn the skill of independence and organising themselves and their time. Those repeatedly not doing it at home will need to do so at break or lunch time.

Online safety and Social media

There is currently much debate going on nationally and internationally regarding children and social media access. There has been an outright ban in Australia and it seems that other countries may follow. We await any updates and further guidance but we have always strongly advised that children of primary school age should not have access to social media and certainly not unattended and unmonitored. If your child is allowed a phone and you allow them to access such sites, please always monitor their phones/tablet and be very vigilant as we are often informed of such frightening stories of children finding themselves at risk on such sites/chats.

Attendance and doctor/dental appointments

We are currently having a lot of children going to medical appointments during the school day. We must remind parents of the importance of children not missing time from school. Please ensure that unless it is an emergency appointment, you schedule doctors and dentist routine appointments for after school. If this cannot be avoided, please try to arrange for the very start/end of the school day. We also request parents show us evidence of any appointments for during school time before we can authorise eg a screenshot or text/email reminder of the booking. Thankyou.
